

Candy Wrapping Instructions – Kit-Kat® Snack-Size Candy Bars

Fits Kit-Kat® 2-Wafer Snack Size Bars – either .56 oz. Or .67 oz

Step 1. *NOTE:* Hershey® produces two sizes of their "Snack size" Kit -Kat bars, both in .56 ounce and .67 ounce sizes. Kit -Kat wrappers are designed to fit either size, however, there is a difference in the length of both bars, and in how the wrappers will fit. The image shows how the wrapper will look on each size.

If you have purchased the smaller .56 ounce size, the wrapper will go right to the edges of the bar. You can trim a small amount off the right and left sides, using scissors, to ensure a more exact fit.

Step 2. Have wrappers, candy, and adhesive (glue stick, double-sided tape, or tape dispenser) ready and on-hand. Place the candy bars and wrappers on a sturdy, clean work surface.

Do the candy bars have flaps on the sides? (see right) If so we recommend, taping the flaps to the back of the bar as shown.

If you are using foils to cover your candy bars, now is the time to wrap in foil. Place the candy bar, front down, onto a sheet of foil. Fold the sides in first, then the top and bottom. There is no need to tape the foil in place.

Step 3. Begin wrapping, by positioning the wrapper in place over the candy bar. (as shown, right) With front-center graphic in place, fold the top down and around to the back of the candy bar, then fold the bottom around and back. Adjust as necessary, then crease gently, and unfold. Unfold the bottom flap.

Step 4. Flip the bar over. Using the creases you made, fold the top flap down tightly so the back is facing you (as shown, right). Apply adhesive over the contact information. Then, fold the bottom flap up and press it into place over the adhesive. Pull this flap tight, to secure the wrapper onto the bar. It should not be able to be slid off the bar easily. If necessary, use your hands to adjust the position of the wrapper. Once it is in the final, correct position, gently crease it in place.

Step 5. Hold the wrapper in place for a few seconds to help set the adhesive. When using tape or tape dispenser, the candy bars are ready immediately. For glue sticks, allow a minimum 20-30 minutes after gluing, before presenting.
