

## Candy Wrapping Instructions – Lifesavers® 14-candy (1.14 ounce) Rolls

Fits any flavor Lifesavers® 14-piece candy rolls

**Step 1.** Have wrappers, candy, and adhesive (glue stick, double-sided tape, or tape dispenser) ready and on-hand. Place the candy bars and wrappers on a sturdy, clean work surface.

**Step 2.** To begin wrapping, place the top edge of the wrapper against the Lifesavers® candy bar as shown. Try to get this edge as straight as possible with that of the candy bar.

**Step 3.** Holding the top edge in place, wrap the wrapper around the candy bar, until you come to the bottom of the wrapper. Then, while still holding it in place, apply adhesive to the top-most 1/2" of the wrapper, as shown. You will be covering the website address with adhesive.

**Step 3.** Flip the bar over. Using the creases you made, fold the top flap down tightly. (This is the smaller flap with contact information on it.) Apply adhesive over the last 1/2" of the flap, or place a strip of double-sided tape across the entire flap as close to the edge as possible. You will be covering up the contact information with adhesive.

**Step 5.** Hold the wrapper in place for a few seconds to help set the adhesive. One good method is to place the candy bar, glued edge down, onto any clean surface, such as a table top, and press down for several seconds. When using tape or tape dispenser, the candy bars are ready immediately. For glue sticks, allow a minimum 20-30 minutes after gluing, before presenting.
