

Candy Wrapping Instructions – Hershey® Miniatures Candy Bars

Fits Hershey® Miniatures Candy Bars

Step 1. Have wrappers, candy, and adhesive (glue stick, double-sided tape, or tape dispenser) ready and on-hand. Place the candy bars and wrappers on a sturdy, clean work surface.

Step 2. Place the wrapper over the candy bar as shown. Then gently wrapper the wrapper around the bar, by wrapping the top flap over first, and then the bottom over last. As you wrap adjust the wrapper as necessary, to ensure it is in the correct position. Make sure all text and graphics are lining up properly. Once you have the wrapper in the correct position, crease it slightly along all edges.

Step 3. Flip the bar over. Using the creases you made, fold the top flap down tightly so the back is facing you. then unfold the top-most flap. The smaller flap with the contact information on it should be showing. Apply adhesive over the last 1/2" of the flap, or place a strip of double-sided tape across the entire flap as close to the edge as possible. You will be covering up the contact information with adhesive.

Step 4. Fold the bottom flap up and press it into place over the adhesive. Pull this flap tight, to secure the wrapper onto the bar. It should not be able to be slid off the bar easily. If necessary, use your hands to adjust the position of the wrapper. Once it is in the final, correct position, gently crease it in place.

Step 5. Hold the wrapper in place for a few seconds to help set the adhesive. When using tape or tape dispenser, the candy bars are ready immediately. For glue sticks, allow a minimum 20-30 minutes after gluing, before presenting.
